Update on dues collections: Forty two of the 160 dues bills for 2024 have been collected as of 11/14/2023. All the unpaid 2024 dues bills have now been mailed. January 15, 2024, is the payment deadline.

Coats For Kids: This is the eighth year we have participated in the KofC Coats For Kids Drive and we hit another record amount of 636 costs purchased at a total cost of \$14,419. Over the last eight years our council has raised \$79,700 for the program through parishioner donations and purchased 3,624 coats which we deliver for distribution to the Catholic Charities Bakersfield location. A thumbs up to Brother Chris Ziemer for chairing all 8 years!

St Vincent DePaul Homeless Center (SVDP): Our parish donated six of the 20 turkeys needed for the annual Thanksgiving dinner for the homeless at the SVDP on November 22, 2023, which is sponsored by the Kern/Inyo chapter consisting of all the sixteen active KofC councils in the two-county area. The turkeys are cooked at the Christ The King council 12719 deep pit and served up by Knights from various chapter councils.
